

**WAYS TO HELP YOUR KIDS LEARN BIBLE VERSES
(SEE, HEAR & DO)**

1. **MAKE IT VISUAL.**
 - a. **PRINT OUT THE BIBLE VERSES AND STICK THEM IN A PLACE WHERE YOU WILL SEE THEM OFTEN. (FRIDGE, BATHROOM MIRROR, FRONT DOOR, TV SCREEN, COMPUTER SCREEN)**
 - b. **PUT A COPY IN YOUR CAR. AS YOU TRAVEL, YOU CAN SAY THE VERSES TOGETHER WITH YOUR KIDS.**
2. **LISTEN TO THE BIBLE**
 - a. **KEEP A COPY OF THE BIBLE VERSES CD IN YOUR CAR SO YOU CAN SAY IT WITH YOUR KIDS WHEN YOU DRIVE.**
 - b. **PLAY THE AUDIO VERSION OF YOU VERSION FROM WWW.YOUVERSION.COM**
3. **GET CREATIVE**
 - a. **GOT MUSICAL TALENT? WRITE A TUNE TO GO WITH THE VERSE**
 - b. **NOT SO MUSICAL? USE A TUNE YOU ALREADY KNOW... LIKE "BINGO, TWINKLE TWINKLE"... OR THE FLINTSTONES THEME SONG**
 - c. **ACT IT OUT - Pictionary style... OR PUT SIGN-LANGUAGE TYPE ACTIONS TO THE WORDS TO HELP KIDS REMEMBER**
4. **REPETITION**
 - a. **SAY THE VERSE WITH YOUR KIDS EVERY DAY, OR AT EVERY MEAL.**
 - b. **SAY THE VERSE WITH YOUR KIDS BEFORE THEY GO TO BED.**
 - c. **SAY THE VERSE WITH YOUR KIDS AS YOU DRIVE IN THE CAR.**
 - d. **MAKE IT PART OF THE DAILY HOMEWORK ROUTINE. THEY CAN WRITE OUT ONE VERSE EVERY DAY FOR A WEEK.**
