## What is the Village of Hope Kisumu?

Village of Hope (VOH) Kisumu is a growing redemptive community outside of Kisumu Kenya offering spiritual, emotional, physical, and educational hope to aids orphans and widows.

### Why would Calvary invest in VOH?

God's church is the hope of the world. At Calvary, we believe it is our calling to impact the world with the saving love of Jesus Christ. We are compelled and committed to focusing our time, prayer, people, and resources to invest in a cause that we believe not only addresses poverty and injustice around the world, but has the potential of changing a community, if not a nation in the years to come.

### How does Calvary plan to invest in VOH?

We are committed to a multi-year focus helping VOH rise to see it's vision become a reality.

#### Prayer...

It is only through a congregation of people praying for God's provision, protection, and direction that we will see God's hand move through our efforts with VOH in the years to come.

#### Provision...

We are committed to providing the resources necessary to help build effective facilities that will make VOH a strong and sustaining redemptive community for aids orphans and widows. As well, it is our pleasure to support our partnering PAOC missionary couple Felix & Cecelia Chiriseri as they bring leadership on-site to VOH.

#### People...

We are committed to launching opportunities for people each year to invest their talents in helping build VOH on two-week mission trips.

## What does it look like?

Currently VOH houses 23 aids orphans and 3 widows as well as maintaining a community school of 225 students pre-school to Grade 5. With so many more in need, here's how we plan to invest over the years to come...

### Building Projects:

- Finishing homes so they are "move in" ready
- Facilities including: Kitchen/storage/dining/washing/ assembly hall for the school and feeding program.
- Safety fencing around the school property
- Playground for school and residential site
- Renovation of Medical Clinic
- Expanded Sewing facility

### Operational Support:

- Daily feeding program
- Teachers salaries to expand number of Grades
- Curriculum for students
- Village maintenance
- Medical Clinic

### Relationship & Life Education:


- Health and safety education for house mothers and children
- Aids awareness and prevention education
- Skills training
- Interactive Bible teaching to children and widows
