Opening Questions:

- ◆ What kind of love does Jesus describe in verse 37?
- ◆ How do we measure the magnitude of our love for Jesus?
- ◆ What does it mean to love your neighbor as yourself?
- ◆ What does God want you to do more than anything else in your job, family, church, and neighborhood?

Read 1 John 3:11 - 24

- ◆ Who is someone (alive or in history) whose life is an example of what it means to love? Hate?
- ◆ What does it mean to love one's brother?
- ◆ When do you struggle with loving other Christians?
- ◆ How do you demonstrate your love for fellow believers?
- ◆ Why is it easier to love with words rather than actions?
- ◆ In what ways does love result in life and hate result in

death?
